MYTH:

Having HIV means
I'll never have
another romantic

or sexual relationship.



FACT:

If you take your HIV drugs as prescribed and your viral load is **Undetectable***, your HIV is **Untransmittable** when you have sex.

*Those who don't have an undetectable viral load can enjoy intimacy too! Condoms and PrEP are available to prevent HIV transmission.

MYTH:

Having HIV means
I can never
have a baby
or start
a family.

FACT:

All around the world, women living with HIV are giving birth to babies who don't have HIV. With proper treatment and care, there is less than a 1% chance of transmitting HIV to your baby.

DidYOUKnow?

People living with HIV who take HIV drugs daily and keep an undetectable viral load

A once daily pill can greatly roduce your risk of acquiring HIV. Ask your doctor about PrEP.

Women make up more than 50% of people living with HIV across the globe.

CANNOT sexually transmit

HIV to their partners.
